What you need to know

You must have veterinary permission before any canine Bowen proceeds. Contact us for a referral form. We can also speak to your vet directly if preferred.

- It is best to allow one hour for the first session and 45 minutes for consequent sessions
- Avoid sessions at busy times of day or when your dog is less likely to be relaxed, such as their dinner time
- Try to take your dog on a relaxed walk beforehand
- If your dog is anxious, choose a day you can be with them or be nearby after the session
- Rest after sessions is essential so avoid long walks, training or sports such as agility
- We suggest you shorten walks for seven days after a session
- If your dog needs daily grooming do this before the Bowen session not after
- We recommend that your dog receives 2-3 sessions of Bowen initially about 7-10 days apart
